

# Homework Policy

Homework will be given out on a regular basis from Monday through Thursday. In rare cases homework may be assigned over the weekend, but I will avoid this as much as possible. Your child's homework should take between 10 and 45 minutes, depending on their work habits. This time does not include long-term projects or studying for tests. All homework is expected to be turned in neatly and on time. Ten points will be deducted for each day that it is late. A note will be sent home in the event an assignment is not turned in.

## Homework Tips

1. Set a regular and specific study time for your child.
2. Make a homework plan for each night.
3. Parents help in getting your child organized before they begin.
4. Don't save the hardest assignment for last.
5. Take a short study break after completing each assignment.
6. Plan a special treat for study breaks.
7. Make special study plans for book reports, projects, and tests.
8. Before going to bed have EVERYTHING ready to go out the door to school the next morning. (Have backpack sitting by the door.)
